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AN ACT PROVIDING FOR LIFE TENURE FOR WALTER T. BARNES, INCUMBENT OF THE OFFICE OF CITY COLLECTOR OF THE CITY OF BEVERLY.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The tenure of office of Walter T. Barnes, in-  
2 cumbent of the office of city collector of the city of Beverly,  
3 shall on the effective date of this act, be unlimited, but he  
4 may be removed therefrom for cause after hearing in the  
5 manner provided by section forty-three of chapter thirty-one  
6 of the General Laws.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its acceptance
