AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE ELIGIBILITY OF THE QUABBIN REGIONAL SCHOOL DISTRICT TO RECEIVE A MATCHING STABILIZATION FUND PAYMENT UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF THE SCHOOL BUILDING ASSISTANCE LAW.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The Quabbin Regional School District, consisting
2 of the towns of Barre, Hardwick, Hubbardston and Oakham
3 shall, if it otherwise qualifies to receive a matching stabiliza-
4 tion fund payment from the commonwealth under the pro-
5 visions of chapter six hundred and forty-five of the acts of
6 nineteen hundred and forty-eight, as amended, in connection
7 with the construction of a regional school, be eligible to re-
8 ceive such stabilization fund payment, notwithstanding the
9 fact that the amount which may be appropriated by the town
10 of Hubbardston from its stabilization fund in the year nine-
11 teen hundred and sixty-five was not contained therein on
12 December thirty-first, nineteen hundred and sixty-four.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
