By Mr. Lamson, a petition of Fred Lamson, George H. O'Farrell and another for legislation to authorize the city of Malden to pay an annuity to Thomas H. Hughes, an employee of the public works department of said city. Pensions and Old Age Assistance.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-Five.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF MALDEN TO PAY AN ANNUITY TO THOMAS H. HUGHES, AN EMPLOYEE OF THE PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT OF SAID CITY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. For the purpose of promoting the public good
2 and in consideration of the long and efficient service of Thomas
3 H. Hughes, who has been employed in the public works depart-
4 ment of the city of Malden for a period of twenty-seven years,
5 and is now physically incapacitated, and notwithstanding any
6 provision of law whether general or special to the contrary,
7 said city is hereby authorized to appropriate and pay to said
8 Thomas H. Hughes an annuity in the sum of sixty-five percent
9 of his wages.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its acceptance by
2 the city of Malden.
