RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY BY THE RETIREMENT LAW COMMISSION RELATIVE TO AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF NORTHAMPTON TO APPROPRIATE AND PAY CERTAIN FORMER CITY EMPLOYEES, NOW RETIRED.

1 *Resolved*, That the retirement law commission is hereby
2 authorized and directed to make an investigation and study
3 of the subject matter of current house document numbered
4 2357, relative to providing for authorizing the city of North-
5 ampton to appropriate and pay certain former city employees,
6 now retired. Said commission shall report to the general
7 court the results of its investigation and study, and its rec-
8 ommendations if any, together with drafts of legislation
9 necessary to carry its recommendations into effect, by filing
10 the same with the clerk of the senate on or before the first
11 Wednesday of December of the current year.
