The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-Five.

AN ACT PLACING THE OFFICE OF BUILDING INSPECTOR OF THE TOWN OF STONEHAM UNDER THE CIVIL SERVICE LAW AND RULES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The office of building inspector of the town of
2 Stoneham shall be subject to the civil service laws and rules.
3 The tenure of office of the incumbent thereof shall, upon the
4 effective date of this act, be unlimited, subject, however, to
5 said law and rules, and provided he passes a qualifying ex-
6 amination to be given by the division of civil service. If he
7 passes said examination, he shall be deemed to be permanently
8 appointed thereto without being required to serve any pro-
9 bationary period.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its acceptance
2 by the town of Stoneham.
