To the Honorable Senate and House of Representatives:

In accordance with the provisions of Article LVI of the Amendments of the Constitution, I am returning, herewith, Senate Bill No. 1221 entitled "An Act Increasing The Compensation Grades Of Court Officers In The District Courts In Suffolk County Other Than In The Municipal Court Of The City Of Boston."

I have no objection to the bill provided it is made subject to acceptance by the City of Boston. This would be in accord with the precedent followed in 1963 when chapter 413 was enacted also dealing with compensation grades of Suffolk County Court officers other than Boston Municipal Court. Therefore, I recommend that the bill be amended by adding at the end a new section:

"SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its acceptance by the city of Boston."
