AN ACT REVISING STATUTORY SALARIES.

1 *Whereas*, The deferred operation of this act would tend to de-
2 feat its purpose, which is to provide without delay additional
3 compensation for certain employees of the commonwealth,
4 therefore, it is hereby declared to be an emergency law, necessary
5 for the immediate preservation of the public convenience.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General
Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Paragraph (f) of section 43 of chapter 31 of the General Laws,
2 as appearing in section 72 of chapter 801 of the acts of 1963, is
3 hereby amended by striking out the fourth sentence and insert-
4 ing in place thereof the following sentence:— Whenever any
5 hearing is held by a member of the commission or some disin-
6 terested person designated by the chairman of the commission,
7 as authorized by paragraph (b) of this section, such person shall
8 be paid a sum not to exceed fifty dollars per day; and such
9 compensation shall be in addition to any compensation pro-
10 vided for in section two A of chapter thirteen.
