AN ACT FURTHER DEFINING THE ESTABLISHMENT OF CERTAIN RESIDENCY REQUIREMENTS FOR APPOINTMENT AS A POLICE OFFICER UNDER CIVIL SERVICE LAW.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 48A of chapter 31 of the General Laws, as inserted  
2 by chapter 857 of the acts of 1967, is hereby amended by strik-  
3 ing out, in line 12, the word "six" and inserting in place thereof  
4 the word: — nine.

The Constitution of the State

Article I. The Legislature

Section 1. The legislative power of this State shall be vested in a Senate and a House of Representatives, which together with the Governor shall constitute the Executive Department of the State.

Section 2. The Senate shall be composed of twenty-four Members, who shall be elected by the qualified electors of the State.

Section 3. The House of Representatives shall be composed of thirty Members, who shall be elected by the qualified electors of the State.
