## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-Nine.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE DIVISION OF FISHERIES AND GAME TO ACQUIRE CERTAIN LAND IN THE TOWN OF CUMMINGTON FOR WILDLIFE MANAGEMENT PURPOSES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 For the purpose of establishing a public area for fishing  
2 hunting and the management thereof, the division of fisheries  
3 and game of the department of natural resources is hereby au-  
4 thorized to acquire on behalf of the commonwealth by eminent  
5 domain under the provisions of chapter seventy-nine of the  
6 General Laws, by purchase or otherwise land in the town of  
7 Cummington, containing eighty acres more or less and described  
8 in a deed from Thomas S. Noska to the Council of Sportsmen's  
9 Clubs of Hampden County, Inc. Said land shall not include  
10 any buildings nor the lots they are presently located upon nor  
11 any tracts now owned by any agency of the federal government.  
12 The attorney general shall approve as to form, the documents  
13 necessary.
