## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-Nine.

AN ACT PLACING CERTAIN EMPLOYEES OF THE DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES WHOSE DUTIES ARE HAZARDOUS UNDER THE "HEART LAW", SO CALLED.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 94 of chapter 32 of the General Laws, as most  
2 recently amended by chapter 15 of the acts of 1968, is hereby  
3 further amended by inserting after the words "General  
4 Edward Laurence Logan International Airport" the following  
5 words:—, or to the director, assistant director, and enforce-  
6 ment officers of the division of law enforcement in the  
7 department of natural resources, or to the chief fire warden,  
8 district fire wardens, patrolmen appointed under section  
9 twenty-eight A of chapter forty-eight of the General Laws,  
10 and such other full-time employees of the division of forest  
11 and parks in the department of natural resources whose  
12 regular duties include the suppression of forest fires.

- 4 Natural Resources Act" the following:
- 5 words, "or to the director, assistant director, and other
- 6 great officers of the division of law enforcement in the
- 7 department of natural resources, or to the chief of the
- 8 division the various persons appointed under section
- 9 twenty-eight A of chapter forty-eight of the General Laws,
- 10 and such other full-time employees of the division of law
- 11 and parks in the department of natural resources whom
- 12 regular duties include the suppression of fire.
