AN ACT RELATING TO THE LICENSING FEE FOR CONVALESCENT HOMES, NURSING HOMES, INFIRMARIES, AND CHARITABLE HOMES FOR THE AGED.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 71 of chapter 111 of the General Laws as most recently
2 amended by chapter 686 of the acts of 1968, is hereby further
3 amended by deleting the seventeenth paragraph and substitut-
4 ing in place thereof the following new paragraph: —

5 The fee for the issue and renewal of each license in the case
6 of a convalescent or nursing home, infirmary maintained in a
7 town, rest home or charitable home for the aged shall be two
8 hundred dollars, and the license shall not be transferable or
9 assignable and shall be issued only for the premises named in
10 the application, except that the fee for the issuance of a tempo-
11 rary, provisional or probationary license shall be one hundred
12 dollars.
