AN ACT TO ESTABLISH THE POSITION OF DIRECTOR OF EDUCATION IN
THE DIVISION OF YOUTH SERVICE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 120 of the General Laws is hereby amended by adding
2 the following section: —

3 *Section 2C.* The director of the division of youth service is
4 hereby directed and authorized to employ forthwith a profes-
5 sional education director with a suitable background of training
6 and experience in this field. His responsibility will be to over-
7 see, revise and reconstruct the vocational training and academic
8 programs and curricula offered at the division's various institu-
9 tions. He shall be classified in Grade 21 for salary purposes,
10 but shall be exempt from the provisions of chapter thirty-one
11 of the General Laws. The sum of fourteen thousand dollars is
12 hereby appropriated for the purpose of carrying out this act.
