*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 The county commissioners of the county of Bristol are hereby
- 2 authorized and directed to have plans and specifications prepared
- 3 for the building of an addition to the fourth district court of
- 4 Bristol county, in the town of Attleboro, not to exceed two
- 5 hundred thousand dollars. For said purposes said commis-
- 6 sioners may expend from available funds a sum not to exceed
- 7 twenty thousand dollars.
