AN ACT RECONSTITUTING THE GREATER LOWELL VOCATIONAL REGIONAL SCHOOL DISTRICT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The vocational regional school district consisting
2 of the city of Lowell and the towns of Dracut, Dunstable and
3 Tyngsborough which was erected and constituted by chapter
4 five hundred and sixty-six of the acts of nineteen hundred and
5 sixty-seven is hereby reconstituted by the addition of the town
6 of Pepperell as a member of said district in accordance with
7 chapter ninety-four of the acts of nineteen hundred and sixty-
8 seven and the agreement signed by the members of the vocational
9 regional school district planning board and dated May eleventh,
10 nineteen hundred and sixty-seven.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect as of October twenty-
2 fifth, nineteen hundred and sixty-seven.
