1 *Resolved*, That a special commission, to consist of two mem-
2 bers of the senate, three members of the house of representatives,
3 and four persons to be appointed by the governor, is hereby
4 established for the purpose of making an investigation and
5 study relative to any action taken by the commissioner of
6 insurance relative to classification of risks based on accident
7 involvement provided for by chapter three hundred and ninety-
8 one of the acts of nineteen hundred and sixty-four relative
9 to the period from September first, nineteen hundred and
10 sixty-four to September first, nineteen hundred and sixty-five
11 and any related matters thereto.
