AN ACT RELEVANT TO FURTHER DEFINING PERSONS AFFECTED BY INSURANCE RATES AND RIGHTS OF PERSONS AGGRIEVED BY APPLICATION OF RATING SYSTEM.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 11 of chapter 174A and section 11 of chapter 175A of
2 the General Laws are hereby amended by adding the following
3 new paragraph: —

4 An insurance agent licensed under the provisions of section one
5 hundred and sixty-three of chapter one hundred and seventy-
6 five and an insurance broker licensed under the provisions of
7 section one hundred and sixty-six of chapter one hundred and
8 seventy-five shall be deemed a "party affected" under the pro-
9 vision of this section.
