AN ACT DIRECTING THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC HEALTH TO MAKE CERTAIN IMPROVEMENTS AT FLAX'S POND IN THE CITY OF LYNN.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 The department of public health is hereby authorized and
- 2 directed to treat the water of Flax's pond in the city of
- 3 Lynn for the control of submerged aquatic vegetation. For
- 4 such purposes, said department may expend for expert ser-
- 5 vices, equipment and other expenses, including chemicals,
- 6 such sums as may be appropriated therefor.

By the Honorable William W. Bennett, Secretary of the
Department of Public Health, for the purpose of treating the water of
the city of Lowell for certain impurities and certain objectionable
matter and impurities.

It is enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same in
this behalf enacted:

1. The Department of Public Health is hereby authorized and
2. directed to treat the water of Plaza Fond in the city of
3. Lowell for the removal of objectionable impurities and
4. such purposes, said department may expend for such
5. other equipment and other expenses, including chemicals,
6. such sums as may be appropriated therefor.
