**The Commonwealth of Massachusetts**

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-Nine.

AN ACT DIRECTING CITIES AND TOWNS TO PROVIDE POLICE DEPARTMENTS WITH RADAR CONTROL EQUIPMENT.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Notwithstanding any provision of law, each city and town
- 2 shall appropriate money for the purchase of radar control
- 3 equipment for its police department.
