AN ACT AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS TO INSTALL TRAFFIC LIGHTS AT THE INTERSECTION OF WASSON AVENUE AND MAIN STREET IN THE CITY OF SPRINGFIELD.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The department of public works is hereby authorized and
2 directed to install traffic lights at the intersection of Wasson
3 avenue and Main street in the city of Springfield to regulate
4 the flow of traffic at said area. Said department may expend
5 such sums as may be appropriated therefor.
