RESOLVE AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE AND ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT TO MAKE A STUDY AND INVESTIGATION OF THE RECREATIONAL, HISTORICAL AND TOURISM ASSETS OF THE COUNTY OF ESSEX AND TO DEVELOP A MASTER PLAN FOR THE FULL UTILIZATION OF SUCH ASSETS.

1 *Resolved*, That the department of commerce and economic
2 development is hereby authorized and directed to make a study
3 and investigation of the recreational, historical and tourism
4 assets of the county of Essex and to develop a master plan for
5 the full utilization of such assets. Said department shall re-
6 view any and all surveys made relative to this subject matter,
7 shall request and seek the cooperation of all public and private
8 agencies within the county of Essex in the course of their study
9 and investigation. Said department may expend such funds as
10 may be appropriated therefor, and may also seek and spend any
11 federal funds which may be made available for such purposes.
12 The department shall file a report with its recommendations, if
13 any, with the clerk of the house of representatives on the first
14 Wednesday of December nineteen hundred and sixty-eight.
