AN ACT DIRECTING THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC HEALTH TO MAKE CERTAIN IMPROVEMENTS AT LAKE BUEL IN THE TOWNS OF MONTEREY AND NEW MARLBOROUGH.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The department of public health is hereby authorized and
2 directed to chemically treat the waters of Lake Buel in the
3 towns of Monterey and New Marlborough for the control of
4 nuisance aquatic vegetation. In the conduct of such work
5 said department shall consider the public health, recreational,
6 and other interests which may be involved. For such pur-
7 pose, said department may expend for expert services, equip-
8 ment, personnel, and other expenses including chemicals such
9 sums as may be appropriated therefor.
