**The Commonwealth of Massachusetts**

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-Nine.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO VETERANS' RETIREMENT BENEFITS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Chapter 32 of the General Laws is hereby amended by  
2 striking out section 60, as most recently amended by section 6  
3 of chapter 498 of the acts of 1965, and inserting in place  
4 thereof the following section:—

5 *Section 60. Sections fifty-six to fifty-nine, inclusive, shall,*  
6 notwithstanding the provisions of any general or special law  
7 relating to retirement allowances, be in effect in any county,  
8 city, town or district which accepted them or accepted  
9 corresponding provisions of law prior to January first, nine-  
10 teen hundred and forty-six, by the retiring authority.

11 No veteran whose employment first begins after January  
12 first, nineteen hundred and fifty shall be subject to the  
13 provisions of sections fifty-six to fifty-nine, inclusive, nor  
14 shall any veteran whose employment first began on or before  
15 said January first, nineteen hundred and fifty be subject to  
16 said provisions unless at the time of his retirement the total  
17 period of his creditable service is at least equal to twice the  
18 time he was not in the employ of the commonwealth or of a  
19 county, city, town, district or housing authority subsequent to  
20 the date when his employment by the commonwealth or by a  
21 county, city, town, district, or housing authority first began.
