AN ACT TO CONTINUE UNEMPLOYMENT BENEFITS FOR DISABLED PERSONS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 24 of chapter 151A of the General Laws is hereby
- 2 amended by striking out the last paragraph, added by
- 3 chapter 528 of the acts of 1966, and inserting in place thereof
- 4 the following paragraph:—
- 5 No individual shall be considered ineligible for benefits
- 6 because of failure to comply with the provisions of said clause
- 7 (b) if such failure is due to an illness or disability which
- 8 occurs during a period of unemployment after he has filed a
- 9 claim and registered for work, and has been determined to be
- 10 otherwise eligible; provided, that, no work which would have
- 11 been considered suitable but for such illness or disability was
- 12 offered to him after he became ill or disabled; provided,
- 13 further, that the exception granted under this paragraph shall
- 14 apply to six weeks only within a benefit year.
