AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE FRAUDULENT CLAIMS BOARD IN THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WELFARE TO REQUEST POLICE ASSISTANCE IN CERTAIN CASES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 5A of chapter 18 of the General Laws is hereby
2 amended by adding at the end the following two sentences:—
3 The appointing authority or the police chief of a city or town
4 shall, upon the written request of the commissioner, detail for
5 police service under the direction of said fraudulent claims
6 board police officers not exceeding two in number. Such police
7 officers shall receive no extra compensation for services thus
8 rendered, and shall be subject to the rules and regulations of
9 their police department, unless relieved therefrom temporarily
10 by said appointing authority or police chiefs.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE POLICE OF THE SEVERAL TOWNS IN THIS COMMONWEALTH.

- 2 amended by adding at the end the following two sentences:—
- 3 The appointing authority in the police chief of a city or town
- 4 shall, upon the written request of the commissioner, detail for
- 5 police service under the direction of said commissioner, such
- 6 board police officers not exceeding two in number. Such police
- 7 officers shall receive no extra compensation for services thus
- 8 rendered, and shall be subject to the rules and regulations of
- 9 the police department, unless relieved therefrom temporarily
- 10 by said appointing authority or police chief.
