AN ACT RELATIVE TO COMPENSATION OF TEACHERS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 40 of chapter 71 of the General Laws as most
2 recently amended by chapter 267 of the acts of 1964 is
3 hereby further amended by adding at the end thereof the
4 following sentence:—Such compensation paid teachers shall
5 be deemed to be fully earned at the end of the school year
6 and proportionately during the school year.
