## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-Nine.

### AN ACT INCREASING THE EXTRA COMPENSATION PAID TO TEACHERS OF SPECIAL CLASSES IN THE PUBLIC SCHOOLS OF THE COMMONWEALTH.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 46E of chapter 71 of the General Laws, as most  
2 recently amended by section 56 of chapter 14 of the acts of  
3 1966, is hereby further amended by striking out the first para-  
4 graph and inserting in place thereof the following para-  
5 graph:—

6 The state treasurer shall annually on or before November  
7 twentieth pay to any city, town or regional school district  
8 certified by the commissioner to have paid teachers of classes  
9 conducted to meet the requirements of section forty-six com-  
10 pensation in excess of the regular compensation paid to its  
11 teachers out of the local aid fund, a sum not to exceed one  
12 thousand dollars for each such teacher so paid.
