AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE LICENSING BOARD FOR THE TOWN OF TYNGSBOROUGH TO ISSUE AN ALL ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES RESTAURANT LICENSE TO THE TEE BIRD CORPORATION.
