AN ACT REQUIRING ALL PUBLIC BUILDINGS TO BE EQUIPPED WITH A SMOKE ALARM SYSTEM APPROVED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 143 of the General Laws is hereby amended by
- 2 inserting after section 24 thereof the following section:—
- 3 *Section 24A.* Each building which is subject to section
- 4 twenty-one and which is not equipped with a sprinkler
- 5 alarm system or a similar device shall be equipped with a
- 6 smoke alarm system approved by the department of public
- 7 safety.
