AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE RELEASE FOR WEEKLY AND WEEKEND DRILLS CERTAIN MEMBERS OF THE ARMED FORCES OF THE COMMONWEALTH AND OF THE UNITED STATES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 33 of the General Laws is hereby amended by
- 2 inserting after section 59 the following section:—
- 3 *Section 59A.* Any person in the service of the common-
- 4 wealth, or of a county, city or town which has accepted the
- 5 provisions of section fifty-nine shall be entitled, during the
- 6 time of his service in the armed forces of the commonwealth
- 7 or during his tour of duty as a member of a reserve com-
- 8 ponent of the armed forces of the United States, to be
- 9 released from his work, without compensation, for assigned
- 10 weekly and weekend drills which require absence from their
- 11 normally scheduled work tour. Such release shall not affect
- 12 his leaves of absence or vacation with pay given to other like
- 13 employees or officials.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF UNITED STATES BONDS AND NOTES IN THE AMOUNT OF FIVE MILLION DOLLARS, AND PROVIDING FOR THE PAYMENT OF THE INTEREST THEREON.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the Senate and House of Representatives, that the Secretary of the Treasury be and he is authorized to issue and sell in the name of the United States, and to pay the interest on the same, the following bonds and notes:

1. Chapter 31 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting after section 1 the following section:—
2. Section 421. Any person in the service of the Government, or of a county, city or town which has accepted the provisions of section 421, shall be entitled during the term of his service to the annual bonus of the Government.
3. or during his term of duty as a member of a house, or
