AN ACT REQUIRING EMPLOYERS TO MAKE CERTAIN REPORTS UPON THE OCCURRENCE OF AN ACCIDENT TO AN EMPLOYEE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 19 of chapter 152 of the General Laws is hereby
2 amended by inserting after the second sentence the following
3 sentence:—Upon the occurrence of an accident involving
4 injury to an employee, the employer shall make a report of
5 such accident in triplicate, retaining one copy for himself,
6 forwarding one copy to the employee and the remaining copy
7 to the insurance company which carries the insurance for
8 such type of accident.
