AN ACT PROVIDING THAT THE MASSACHUSETTS REHABILITATION COMMISSION PROVIDE PROGRAMS FOR CERTAIN EDUCABLE CHILDREN.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 81 of chapter 6 of the General Laws, as amended by
2 section 2 of chapter 602 of the acts of 1956, is hereby further
3 amended by adding at the end thereof the following sentence: —
4 The commission shall establish and operate a program spe-
5 cifically directed to and for the benefit of educable school chil-
6 dren over the age of sixteen.
