## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

### AN ACT PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR THE ACCEPTANCE OF LIQUOR BY MINORS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Chapter 138 of the General Laws is hereby amended by  
2 striking out section 34A, inserted by chapter 145 of the acts  
3 of 1935, and as amended by section 35 of chapter 440 of the  
4 acts of 1935, and inserting in place thereof the following new  
5 section:—

6 *Section 34A.* Whoever, being a minor, makes a false state-  
7 ment as to his age in order to procure a sale or delivery of  
8 alcoholic beverages or alcohol, either for his own use or for  
9 the use of another, or accepts service or delivery of any alco-  
10 holic beverage for consumption on the same premises, and who-  
11 ever knowingly makes a false statement as to the age of a minor  
12 in order to procure a sale or delivery of such beverages or alco-  
13 hol to such minor, either for the use of the minor or for the use  
14 of some other person, and whoever induces a minor to make a  
15 false statement as to his age in order to procure a sale or deliv-  
16 ery of such beverages or alcohol to such minor shall be pun-  
17 ished by a fine of not less than ten nor more than one hundred  
18 dollars.
