AN ACT RELATING TO ATTORNEYS WHO REPRESENT INSURANCE COMPANIES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Any attorney at law who represents an insurance company
- 2 shall be required to so indicate in his telephone listing or on
- 3 the door of his office. Such designation shall include the name
- 4 of the company so represented.
