AN ACT PROHIBITING THE ALTERATION, FORGERY, ETC. OF LICENSES, PERMITS, ETC.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 131 of the General Laws is hereby amended by
2 striking out section 117B and inserting in place thereof the
3 following new section:—

4 *Section 117B.* A person shall not alter, forge, or counter-
5 feit any license, permit, permit application, or certificate
6 issued under any provision of this chapter, nor possess or use
7 any such altered, forged, or counterfeited license, permit, per-
8 mit application, or certificate, nor procure or attempt to pro-
9 cure a license, permit, permit application, or certificate by
10 fraud or false statements of any kind, nor use or attempt to
11 use any license, permit, permit application, or certificate of
12 another, nor loan or allow another person to use his license,
13 permit, permit application, or certificate. Violation of this
14 section shall be subject to a fine of not less than twenty dol-
15 lars nor more than fifty dollars.
