AN ACT AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF STATE COLLEGES TO ESTABLISH A COURSE OF STUDY AT THE STATE COLLEGE AT BOSTON FOR TRAINING STUDENTS TO GIVE INSTRUCTIONS TO DEAF CHILDREN, SPEECH HANDICAPPED CHILDREN AND HEARING-IMPAIRED CHILDREN.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 The board of trustees of state colleges is hereby authorized
- 2 and directed to establish a course of study at the state college
- 3 in Boston for the purpose of training students to give instruc-
- 4 tions to deaf children, speech-handicapped children and hearing-
- 5 impaired children.
