Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The first clause of the third sentence of section nine of
2 chapter one hundred and forty-three of the General Laws
3 is hereby stricken out and the following clause inserted:—
4 The costs and charges incurred shall constitute a lien upon
5 the land upon which the building is located and shall be
