AN ACT EXTENDING THE RIGHTS AND PRIVILEGES OF VETERANS TO CERTAIN MEMBERS OF THE ARMED FORCES WHO SERVED IN THE YANGTZE RIVER CAMPAIGN AND IN TIENTSIN.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Clause Forty-third of section 7 of chapter 4 of the General

The Constitution of Oregon.

Article I.

§ 1. All legislative powers herein granted shall be vested in a Congress of the United States, which shall consist of a Senate and House of Representatives.

§ 2. The Congress shall assemble at least once in every year, and such meeting shall begin on the first Monday in December, unless otherwise provided by law.

§ 3. The Congress shall hold regular sessions in every second year, and may adjourn from time to time, and may, in any case, adjourn for longer than six days, and may, by law, provide for the calling of special sessions in any year.

§ 4. The Congress shall assemble at least once in every year, and such meeting shall begin on the first Monday in December, unless otherwise provided by law.

§ 5. The Yangtze River Campaign and "Tientsin" shall
