## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-Nine.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO CERTIFICATION BY THE COMPTROLLER OF CERTAIN ACCOUNTS AND DEMANDS AGAINST THE COMMONWEALTH.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 13 of chapter 7 of the General Laws, as amended by  
2 chapter 272 of the acts of 1950, is hereby further amended by  
3 striking out the fourth sentence thereof and inserting in place  
4 thereof the following:—The comptroller shall make a cer-  
5 tificate specifying the amount due and allowed on each account  
6 or demand so examined, the name of the person to whom such  
7 amount is payable, and the account to which it is chargeable.
