AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE OBSERVANCE OF ELECTION DAY AS A
STATE HOLIDAY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding the provisions of chapter six hundred and
2 sixteen of the acts of nineteen hundred and sixty-two, and of
3 any other special or general laws to the contrary, the first
4 Tuesday after the first Monday in November in every even-
5 numbered year shall henceforth be a legal holiday in the
6 commonwealth.
