

HOUSE No. 1430

By Mr. Bly of Saugus, petition of Belden G. Bly, Jr., that the Department of Public Works be directed to dredge Pranker's Pond in Saugus and that such pond be designated as a great pond. Natural Resources and Agriculture.

AN ACT PROVIDING THAT PRANKER'S POND IN SAUGUS BE A GREAT POND AND THAT IT BE DREDGED.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Pranker's pond in the town of Saugus is hereby
2 designated a "great pond", as defined in section thirty-five of
3 chapter ninety-one of the General Laws.

1 SECTION 2. For the purposes of carrying out the provisions
2 of section one above, the department of public works may
3 take by eminent domain under chapter seventy-nine of the
4 General Laws, or acquire by purchase or otherwise, all lands,
5 water rights, rights of way and easements within the town of
6 Saugus which the department may deem necessary for the
7 purposes of this act.

1 SECTION 3. The department of public works is hereby
2 authorized and directed to dredge Pranker's pond in the town
3 of Saugus. For said purposes said department may expend
4 such sums as may be appropriated therefor.
