AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE INSPECTION OF HOTELS AND MOTELS TO DETERMINE THE ADEQUACY OF ESCAPE EXITS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as
follows:*

- 1 Chapter 143 of the General Laws is hereby amended by
- 2 inserting after section 28 the following section:—
- 3 *Section 28A.* The department shall from time to time
- 4 examine and inspect all hotels and motels for the purpose of
- 5 determining the adequacy of all escape exits particularly
- 6 those located above the fifth floor of such buildings.
