AN ACT AMENDING THE LAW PROVIDING PENSIONS FOR CERTAIN WIDOWS OF POLICE OFFICERS AND FIRE FIGHTERS KILLED IN LINE OF DUTY.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 100 of chapter 32 of the General Laws is hereby  
2 amended by inserting after the word, "person" in line 5, the  
3 following:—or as a result of an accident involving a police  
4 department vehicle which he is operating or in which he is  
5 riding in the performance of his duty as a police officer.
