

HOUSE No. 1478

By Mr. Lolas of Monson, petition of Alexander Lolas for legislation to permit certain retired members of the Division of State Police to be employed by cities and towns without loss of pension rights. Public Service.

AN ACT PERMITTING CERTAIN RETIRED STATE POLICE OFFICERS TO BE EMPLOYED BY POLITICAL SUBDIVISIONS OF THE COMMONWEALTH WITHOUT LOSS OF PENSION RIGHTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 91 of chapter 32 of the General Laws, as amended,
2 is hereby further amended by adding the following sen-
3 tence:—Notwithstanding the foregoing provisions of this
4 section or similar provisions of law, any person who was
5 retired from the commonwealth and served as a state police
6 officer at the time of his retirement may be employed by any
7 city or town or other political subdivision of the common-
8 wealth and such employment shall not affect the pension
9 rights or amount of pension of any such person.
