### AN ACT PLACING CERTAIN PERSONS IN THE EMPLOY OF THE CITIES AND TOWNS UNDER THE HEART LAW.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Notwithstanding any provisions of any law, all persons in
- 2 the employ of a department of public buildings in any city or
- 3 town shall be covered by the provisions of section ninety-four
- 4 of chapter thirty-two of the General Laws.
