AN ACT PROVIDING CERTAIN EXEMPTIONS FROM REAL ESTATE TAXES FOR CERTAIN WIDOWS AND MINORS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Clause Seventeenth of section 5 of chapter 59
2 of the General Laws, as most recently amended by chapter 371
3 of the acts of 1966, is hereby further amended by striking
4 out the first sentence and inserting in place thereof the fol-
5 lowing sentence: — Real Estate, to the value of two thousand
6 dollars or the sum of one hundred and seventy-five dollars,
7 whichever would result in an abatement of the greater amount
8 of actual taxes due, of a widow, or of any minor whose father
9 is deceased, occupied by such widow, or minor as her or his
10 domicile, or a person or persons over the age of seventy who
11 has owned and occupied it as a domicile for not more than ten
12 years.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect with respect to taxes
2 assessed in the nineteen hundred sixty-nine calendar year
3 and thereafter.
