AN ACT EXEMPTING VETERANS ORGANIZATIONS FROM THE PROVISIONS  
OF THE SALES TAX.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Notwithstanding the provisions of chapter fourteen of the  
2 acts of nineteen hundred and sixty-six, all items purchased  
3 by, and for use by, all veterans organizations in the common-  
4 wealth are hereby exempted from the sales tax.
