AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE EXPENSES OF MAINTENANCE AND REPAIR OF OVERHEAD BRIDGES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 77 of chapter 159 of the General Laws is hereby
2 amended by striking out the words between the first colon
3 and the first semicolon and substituting therefor the follow-
4 ing: —

5 If the public way crosses the railroad by an overhead
6 bridge, the substructure of the bridge and its abutments or
7 other supports shall be maintained and kept in repair by the
8 railroad corporation, but the approaches of the bridge, and
9 the subflooring and the pavement or wearing surface over the
10 subflooring shall be maintained and kept in repair by the city
11 or town where situated, or, in case such public way is a state
12 highway, by the commonwealth;
