## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-Nine.

AN ACT INCREASING THE AMOUNT OF MONEY APPROPRIATED FOR SCHOLARSHIPS OFFERED BY THE BOARD OF HIGHER EDUCATION.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 There shall be annually appropriated an additional sum of  
2 two million dollars for use by the board of higher education  
3 in administering a scholarship program in accordance with  
4 the provisions of section one D of chapter fifteen of the  
5 General Laws, with the particular purpose of providing a  
6 greater number of scholarships for students of parents of "low  
7 income", as defined by the commissioner of education.

The Committee on Education, of the House of Representatives, has the honor to acknowledge the receipt of your communication of the 15th inst., and in reply to inform you that the same has been referred to the subcommittee on Higher Education.
