In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-Nine.

AN ACT PROVIDING FOR ADDITIONAL PENALTIES FOR THE OBSTRUCTION OF AN ENGINE OR TRAIN.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 226 of chapter 160 of the General Laws is hereby
- 2 amended by adding the following paragraph:—
- 3 Wherever the acts complained of in this section are per-
- 4 formed by an unemancipated minor or minors and said acts
- 5 result in injury to person or damage to property and said
- 6 unemancipated minor or minors have been apprehended and
- 7 found guilty of such act, then the parent, parents or guardian
- 8 of such unemancipated minor or minors shall likewise for
- 9 each subsequent offense forfeit to the use of the corporation
- 10 treble the amount of damages which it has sustained thereby
- 11 and said minor, minors, parent, parents or guardian shall be
- 12 jointly and severally liable to indemnify said railroad corpo-
- 13 ration against any judgments recovered against it as a result
- 14 of any act herein complained of; provided nothing herein
- 15 shall be construed to relieve such minor from personal
- 16 liability for such injury or damage. The liability herein
- 17 provided shall be in addition to and not in lieu of any other
- 18 liability which may exist at law.

Section 101. (a) The Board of Directors of the Corporation shall have the authority to make and alter the bylaws of the Corporation, subject to the power of the stockholders to change or repeal the same at any time.

Section 102. (a) The Corporation shall have the authority to acquire, hold, lease, convey, mortgage, and otherwise dispose of real and personal property, and to incur liabilities therefor.

Section 103. (a) The Corporation shall have the authority to borrow money, to issue bonds, notes, debentures, or other securities, and to incur liabilities therefor.

Section 104. (a) The Corporation shall have the authority to make and alter its articles of incorporation, subject to the approval of the stockholders.

Section 105. (a) The Corporation shall have the authority to make and alter its articles of association, subject to the approval of the stockholders.

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Section 113. (a) The Corporation shall have the authority to make and alter its articles of association, subject to the approval of the stockholders.
