AN ACT RELATIVE TO CERTAIN MOTOR VEHICLES TRANSPORTING
SCHOOL CHILDREN.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 7D of chapter 90 of the General Laws, as amended by
2 chapter 502 of the acts of 1950, is hereby stricken out and the
3 following section inserted in place thereof: —

4 *Section 7D. Designation of certain motor vehicles used for the*
5 *transportation of school children.* The requirements of clauses
6 (1), (5) and (7) of section seven B shall apply to any motor
7 vehicle having permanent seating accommodations for and carry-
8 ing eight or nine persons in addition to the operator, regularly
9 used for the transportation of school children while so used.
